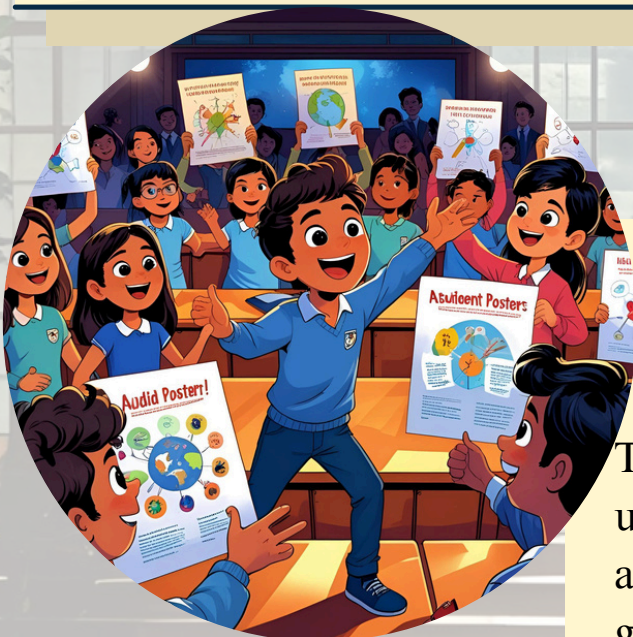
● SUCCESSFUL TEST-FIRING OF AGNI-5 BALLISTIC MISSILE

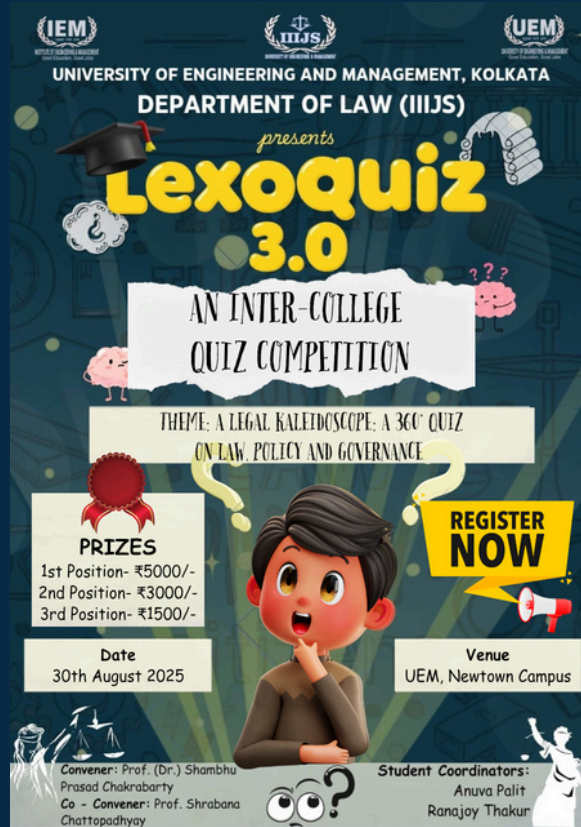
