**Subject: Memorandum of Understanding for Student Support and other Engagement
(non-commercial)**

A non-commercial Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Smile Foundation and your esteemed College to collaborate on student-centric initiatives aimed at enhancing educational access, skill development, employability, and academic engagement. This partnership is based purely on mutual interest and shared values.

Scope of Collaboration

1. Scholarship Facilitation

- a. The college will support the Smile Foundation in identifying and recommending deserving meritorious first-year students (or any subsequent year on a case-to-case basis) from economically weak backgrounds for scholarship opportunities.
- b. College will ensure that the students identified and recommended to Smile Foundation are not part of any other scholarships or fee waiver schemes.
- c. The College will undertake to provide complete verified documentation, including semester-wise fee structures and proof of student enrolment, as required by Smile Foundation, from time to time.
- d. The College will share college bank account details to facilitate direct disbursement of approved scholarship amounts from year II onwards or as per the terms communicated by Smile Foundation from time to time.
- e. Upon receipt of scholarship funds, the College will provide an official confirmation letter acknowledging the amount received, this shall be accompanied with a detailed listing and student-wise details.

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Smile Foundation recognises education as the main tool that empowers individuals to make informed choice, resist oppression and fight for their rights. - f. Any documentation needed for review, reporting, or audits will be shared by the College within 5 working days upon a request by Smile Foundation.

2. Skill Development & Training

- a. The College will extend the support by way of making its premises available and infrastructure support to conduct in-campus training programs, bootcamps, and workshops focused on core employability and/or branch-specific and industry-relevant skills such as coding, communication, placement readiness, technical proficiency.
- b. Smile Foundation will coordinate the delivery of these sessions. Towards the delivery of these sessions, Smile Foundation may seek support from the College's faculty or external experts as required.

3. Internship & Placement Support

- a. College will provide internship opportunities and allow scholars to pursue internship during the suitable time of the course aligning with the academic calendar.
- b. The college's R&D and incubation centres may support student innovation and entrepreneurship by offering project-based internships, startup exposure, and guidance for research & patent development.
- c. Assist in organizing mock interviews, placement drives, and providing exposure to hiring trends.

4. Mutual Support & Networking

- a. A faculty member/s will be nominated by college as a Single Point of Contact (SPOC) to coordinate activities under this MoU
- b. Faculty member/s may also collaborate with Smile Foundation to support student mentoring, evaluate projects, and provide guidance on innovation and research initiatives
- c. The College may connect Smile with the corporates in their network that are interested in engaging with NGOs to initiate activities under the CSR Mandate
- d. Smile Foundation welcomes collaboration with the college faculty in mentoring students, participating in training programs, and guiding project-based learning.

5. Academic Events & Knowledge Exchange

- a. The college and Smile Foundation may jointly organize or collaborate in academic events, including national conferences, technical colloquiums, and innovation competitions.
- b. Smile Foundation may support and collaborate in student-focused events or academic programs organized by the College, including workshops, seminars, conferences, or skill development sessions.

Nature of the MoU

This is a non-commercial and goodwill-based agreement, where both parties agree to collaborate purely for educational and developmental purposes, without any commercial intent or exchange of funds beyond scholarship facilitation.

Validity and Termination

This MoU will remain in force for a period of (year to be mentioned) from the date of signing and may be extended upon mutual agreement. Either party may terminate the MoU with a written notice of 30 days, ensuring any ongoing commitments are fulfilled in good faith.
