

**Addendum dated 15.08.2022 to the Memorandum of
Understanding dated 06.08.2021 entered into**

and
UNIVERSITY OF ENGINEERING & MANAGEMENT (UEM), JAIPUR

I. INTRODUCTION

This **Addendum to the Memorandum of Understanding dated 06.08.2021** (“**Addendum**”) is made at UNIVERSITY OF ENGINEERING & MANAGEMENT (UEM), JAIPUR, on this 15th day of August 2022.

Between

Pupilfirst Private Limited, bearing CIN U74999KL2017PTC069556, a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 2013 and having its office at International Center for Free and Open Source Software (ICFOSS), Swatantra, Karyavattom, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala, India — 695581 hereinafter referred to as “**Pupilfirst**” of the FIRST PART

AND

UNIVERSITY OF ENGINEERING & MANAGEMENT (UEM), JAIPUR, having its address at “GURUKUL”, 6 kms from Chomu on Sikar Road (NH-11), Udaipuria Mod, Jaipur-303807, Rajasthan hereinafter referred to as the “**Institute**” of the SECOND PART

Pupilfirst and Institute shall hereinafter be collectively referred to as the “**Parties**” and individually as the “**Party**”.

WHEREAS

- A. The Parties had entered into a Memorandum of Understanding dated 07.06.2022 (“**MOU**”) to set out the proposed collaboration between the Parties with regard to the LITE Program and their respective rights, responsibilities and obligations in relation to implementation of the Courses (as defined in the MOU) in the Institute. In pursuance to the execution of the MOU, the Institute has completed the minor degree integration process as required for delivery of the Courses at the Institute.
- B. In the interest of training students who can become Teaching Assistants (TAs) to deliver future Courses (which in turn will enable AICTE and Pupilfirst to offer the Courses to a larger population of students), Pupilfirst will be offering the WD101 Course proposed tentatively to be conducted during August-September 2022 as an Interest-Based Admission Test (I-BAT) **free of cost** to all interested students at the Institute who fill out and submit completed interest forms subject to them satisfying clause 2.2 of this Addendum. A select number of these students who complete WD 101 successfully will be offered WD 201 Course on a 100% scholarship basis, tentatively to be conducted

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from September 2022 to January 2023. The batch of students who undergo the WD 101 Course in August-September 2022 and the batch of students who undergo the WD 201 Course in September 2022-January 2023 shall hereinafter collectively be referred to as the “**WD Batch 2 2022**”.

- C. In addition to the proposal to conduct the WD Batch 2 2022, there is a change in certain details relating to the Courses set out in the MOU.
- D. The Parties are entering into this Addendum to (a) amend certain terms of the MOU as specifically set out herein and (b) to capture their understanding with regard to the WD Batch 2 2022 to be conducted.

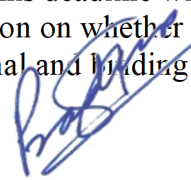
NOW, THEREFORE, THIS ADDENDUM WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1.0 Definitions and Construction

- 1.1 Capitalized terms used herein but not defined shall have the meaning as ascribed to them in the MOU.
- 1.2 Other than the amendments set out in this Addendum, all other terms and conditions of the MOU along with the schedules thereto shall continue to bind the Parties as before and none of the rights and obligations of either Party to the MOU shall be deemed to have been altered or modified in any way, except as specifically provided herein.
- 1.3 The MOU shall be read in conjunction with this Addendum and shall constitute the entire understanding between the Parties relating to the subject matter hereof and supersedes and extinguishes any prior arrangement or understanding (whether oral or in writing) in relation to the subject matter hereof.
- 1.4 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this Addendum and the MOU, the provisions of this Addendum shall prevail in relation to the subject matter hereof.

2.0 Roles and Responsibilities of Pupilfirst in relation to the WD Batch 2 2022

- 2.1 Preparation and submission of interest forms: Pupilfirst shall prepare and submit to the Institute interest form(s) which students interested in (and who are qualified for it based on the department and semester in which they are enrolled) undergoing the WD 101 Course (in the WD Batch 2 2022) may fill out.
- 2.2 On-boarding of students to the WD 101 Course: Pupilfirst shall on-board to the WD 101 Course all students who meet the eligibility requirement for the minor degree (as previously decided and discussed with the Institute) who submit completed interest forms on or before its given deadline, this deadline will be communicated by Pupilfirst to Institute. Pupilfirst's decision on whether or not a student has submitted a complete interest form shall be final and binding on the


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Institute and the concerned student.

- 2.3 Delivering the WD 101 Course & Ensuring Engagement- Pupilfirst shall, with the engagement of Coaches (Industry Expert) and TAs, deliver the WD 101 Course to the WD Batch 2 2022 free of cost to the on-boarded students. From the date of commencement of the WD 101 Course until the deadline mentioned, students can access the course but will be required to complete the WD 101 Course within the deadline mentioned. The course's end date and key course deadlines for the WD Batch 2 2022 will be included in the information material prepared by Pupilfirst and shared with the Institute.
- 2.4 Selecting students to undergo the WD 201 Course in the WD Batch 2 2022 on a scholarship basis: Pupilfirst shall onboard eligible students who successfully complete the WD 101 Course in the WD Batch 2 2022 within the timelines and such selected students ("**Scholarship Students**") shall be entitled to undergo the WD 201 Course in the WD Batch 2 2022 on a full scholarship basis on a first-come-first served basis. Pupilfirst will on-board as many eligible students as it can to the WD 201 Course in the WD Batch 2 2022 and the remaining shall be added onto a waitlist. The students on the waitlist will be informed and onboarded to the WD 201 Course in the WD Batch 2 2022 at a suitable juncture by Pupilfirst. Such on-boarding of waitlisted students to the WD 201 Course shall be done until a specific date in the course calendar, viz. one month before the course end date as set out in the course calendar ("**Cut-Off Date**"). Students will be encouraged to complete the WD 201 Course at their own pace and well before the deadlines if they can and want to (which in turn will enable Pupilfirst to onboard more students). Students who continue to be on the waitlist after the Cut-Off Date will be considered towards the next batch of WD 201 Course that are conducted at the Institute on a scholarship basis.
- 2.5 The WD 201 NEAT approved course fee of INR 10,000/- shall be borne by Pupilfirst for all the Scholarship Students undergoing the WD 201 Course in the WD Batch 2 2022 (or future batches which are conducted for students who complete the WD 101 Course in the WD Batch 2 2022 within the timelines as mentioned above). The list of the Scholarship Students who are selected to undergo the WD 201 Course in the WD Batch 2 2022 will be shared with the Institute.
- 2.6 Delivering the WD 201 Course & Ensuring Engagement: Pupilfirst shall, with the engagement of Coaches (Industry Experts) and TAs, administer/deliver the WD 201 Course to the Scholarship Students on a full scholarship basis (i.e. with a full waiver of the INR 10,000 NEAT approved course fee that is otherwise applicable to the WD 201 Course). Scholarship Students who drop out on their own or who Pupilfirst in its sole discretion believe are either unable to cope with/keep up with the Course work within the set timelines and in accordance with the Course plan (as set by Pupilfirst) or with whose information submitted, Pupilfirst finds any discrepancies (such as department, semester etc), shall be dropped from the WD Batch 2 2022 and shall no longer be eligible to be part of the WD Batch 2 2022 and undertake the WD 201 Course nor be eligible for the scholarship. Pupilfirst may in its sole discretion adjust the scholarship fee attributable to a Scholarship Student who dropped out for future batches of the WD 201 Course that it may conduct on a scholarship basis (full or part).

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2.7 **Onboarding TAs:** Students who complete the WD 101 and WD 201 Courses in the WD Batch 2 2022 successfully, will be onboarded as TAs. During their work as a TA, they will be working under the guidance of the Coaches, who are experts from the Industry. Suitable stipend/remuneration along with a certificate will be given to the TAs for their contribution.

2.8 All other roles and responsibilities of Pupilfirst in relation to the delivery of Courses as set out in the MOU shall apply to the WD Batch 2 2022.

3.0 Roles and Responsibilities of the Institute in relation to the WD Batch 2 2022

3.1 The Institute shall circulate the materials and interest forms generated by Pupilfirst widely amongst all its students and explain to the students who are interested in applying, the benefits of the WD 101 and WD 201 Courses and expectations in terms of their commitment towards becoming a TA for one or more future batches of the Courses to be conducted at the Institute or elsewhere.

3.2 The Institute will provide all necessary assistance and co-operation as may be required by Pupilfirst in conducting and delivering the WD 101 and WD 201 Courses to the WD Batch 2 2022 as contemplated in this Addendum.

3.3 All other roles and responsibilities of the Institute in relation to the delivery of the Courses to its students as set out in the MOU shall apply to the WD Batch 2 2022.

4.0 Addition of new Clause 1.7 to Clause 1 of the MOU

4.1 After Clause 1.6, Clause 1.7 shall be newly added as follows:
To enhance the opportunity for internships and hiring for students from LITE Institutions, the LITE Hiring Network has been launched with 69 companies. This employability program is supported by ACT Grants, the collective of India's leading venture capitalists and startups so that startups and reputed software organizations can hire graduating students from the minor degree track. The list of companies is available at wd.pupilfirst.org.

Prior updates regarding the same will be communicated to the Principal Coordinator of the Institute. **The Institute understands and acknowledges that while the LITE Hiring Network program will give an opportunity to students of the Institute who undergo the Courses to apply to companies/entities that are part of the LITE Hiring Network (subject to their meeting other criteria for such application as may be applicable to each such companies/entities) neither Pupilfirst nor AICTE guarantee internships or jobs to the said students.**



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5.0 Amendments to Clause 9 of the MOU

5.1 Clause 9.1 shall stand modified and be replaced with the following clause:

Pupilfirst may use the name, logo, photo and faculty member details of the Institute in connection with the promotion, marketing and delivery of the Courses and the LITE Program after a prior intimation to the Principal Coordinator of the Institute.

5.2 Clause 9.2 shall stand deleted in its entirety and instead replaced with the following clause:

LITE - Learning Analytics Research Network.

Dr Leena Chandran Wadia, Member, Technical Secretariat to the Dr K. Kasturirangan Committee for preparation of the National Education Policy (NEP) and Member, Drafting Committee of the Draft NEP 2019 and **Dr Viraj Kumar**, Member, Technical Secretariat to the Dr K. Kasturirangan Committee for preparation of the National Education Policy and Member, Technical Secretariat to the Steering Committee for the development of the National Curriculum Framework (hereinafter collectively referred to as “**Co-Principal Investigators or Co-PIs**”) have been tasked by Pupilfirst with the following responsibilities in connection with the implementation of the LITE Digital Classrooms (“**Research Purpose**”):

(i) They shall set up and manage the Learning Analytics Research Network (LeARN), as part of the LITE Digital Learning Engine to observe, analyse and provide guidelines and recommendations to AICTE and other regulatory bodies to further innovate the teaching-learning pedagogies under the LITE Program.

(ii) They shall share a report with AICTE/Regulators on their observations based on their research for improving the implementation guidelines of the LITE Program (“**Observations and Research Reports**”).

In connection with the Research Purpose, the Co-PIs shall be given access to data regarding the delivery/management of Courses by Pupilfirst. The data shared with them will be purely for the Research Purpose and the same will not be released to third parties. Further, no personal data (such as names, email ids and other such personally identifiable information) will be shared with the Co-PIs.

A copy of the Observation and Research Reports shall be shared with the Institute to enable it to undertake continuous improvements to increase the efficiency of the LITE Classroom.



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6.0 Amendment to Schedule 2 of the MOU

6.1 The table set out in Schedule 2 of the MOU, which outlines the Courses and credits which shall be offered at the Institute under the LITE Program shall stand replaced with the following table.

*The Web Development 201 Course has been updated from Ruby on Rails to Node.js in the revised model curriculum. The revised curriculum has been shared with AICTE for publication.

6.2 Barring the replacement of the table as set out above, all other information and details set out in Schedule 2 shall remain the same.



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7.0 Effective Date

7.1 This Addendum shall become effective from the date of execution hereof (“**Effective Date**”) and shall be co-terminus with the MOU.

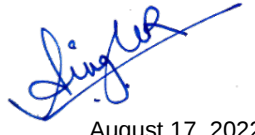
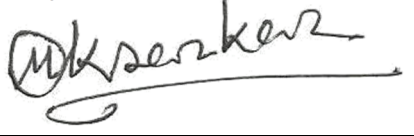
8.0 Miscellaneous
