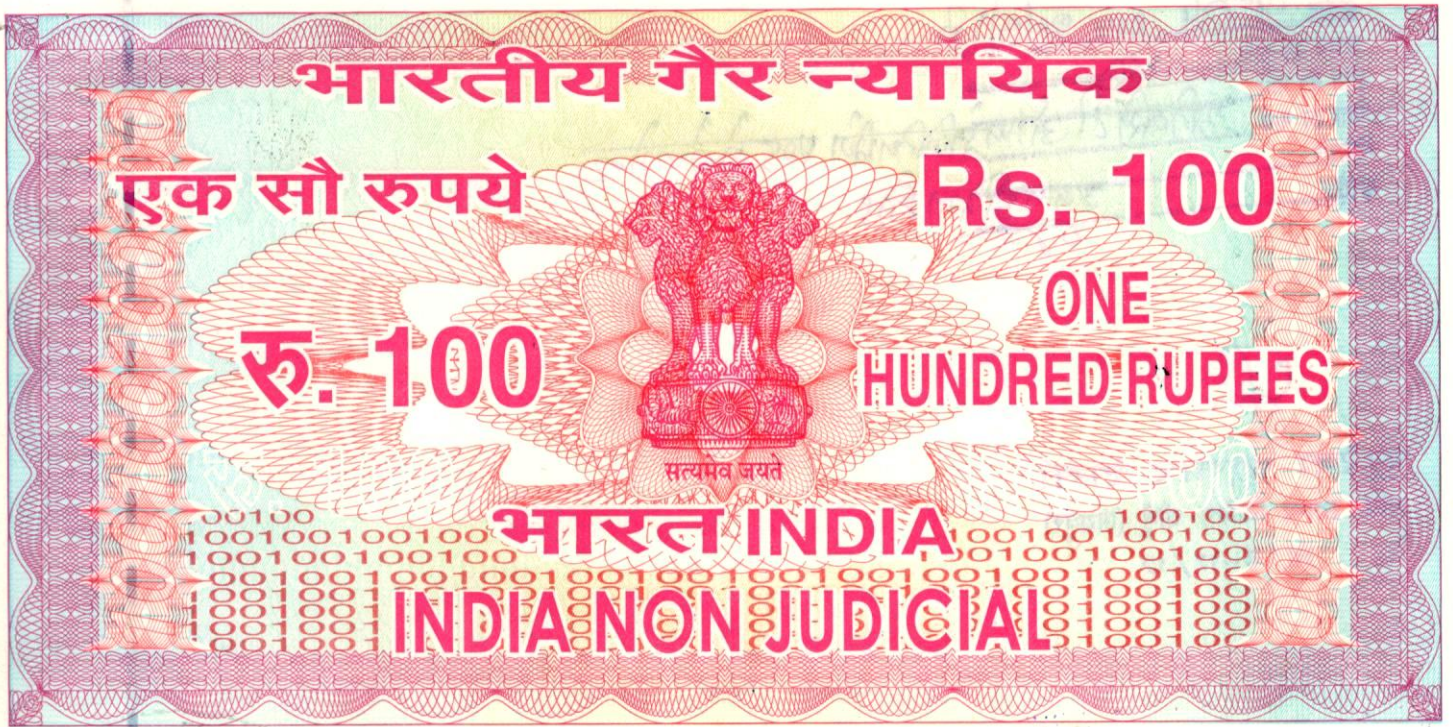

WHERE AS

Smart Society is agreeable to enter into this MoU with University of Engineering & Management, Jaipur as per the terms and conditions set out hereunder:

Now this MoU witnesses as under:

1.0. Objectives of collaboration

- 1.1. To collaborate and co-operate with each other in order to enhance the quality of teaching and research activities.
- 1.2. To provide for exchange of faculties and researchers of one institution with the other institution.
- 1.3. To provide opportunities for both faculty members and researchers to use the expertise and facilities available in both institutions through training of faculty/researchers and through exchange of thoughts by brain storming sessions/seminars/workshops and conferences.
- 1.4. To share research infrastructure and expertise available at UEMJ with SMART Society, USA under mutually agreed framework.
- 1.5. To jointly publish research papers in reputed international journals and leverage the same for developing additional collaborative linkages through extramural funding schemes.
- 1.6. To work jointly for the common research interest at national and international level. This includes preparation of research proposals as per the national priorities.
- 1.7. To support the exchange of academic and training material including access to library and other digital resources of each other.
- 1.8. To encourage any other activities that both the institutions agree to be of mutual benefit.

2.0. Areas of Collaboration

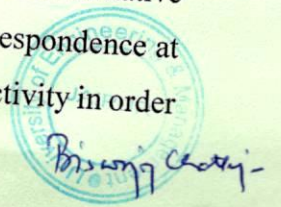
UEMJ and SMART Society may collaborate within any mutually agreeable field of research and education.

3.0. Exchange of Faculty and Research Scholars

- 3.1. UEMJ and SMART Society, USA will encourage collaboration in research and education in areas of mutual interest, through reciprocal arrangements for faculty and research scholar exchanges.
- 3.2. As feasible, and contingent upon cognizant parent organization or departmental approval, the administrations of the two institutions agree to assist their respective faculty members in developing scholarly exchanges that may include a range of interactions such as research collaboration, specialized lectures, seminars and teaching or submission of joint research proposals.

parties must agree upon the specific terms of any inter-institution initiative relative to this agreement in written or electronically recorded correspondence at least three months prior to the initiation of a particular program or activity in order for the said initiative to proceed.

coordinate support with the visiting institution for office space, library, laboratory and other privileges appropriate to the level and purpose of the visit, subject to the availability of resources.

4.0. Research Projects

- 4.1. Interested faculty of either institution may initiate joint research projects. Subject to available funding, the Parties will encourage research centers of their respective institutions to initiate and conduct collaborative projects consistent with the other terms and specifications of this agreement. Such joint research projects are to be the subject of definitive project agreements specific to each project and separate from this MoU.
- 4.2. The financial arrangement relating to each joint research project will be in accordance with the specific agreement covering each project.

5.0. Confidentiality

- 5.1. Both parties hereunder agree that any information disclosed by one party to the other while carrying out collaborative activities under this MoU shall be maintained as proprietary confidential information and will be disclosed only to the authorities as required in the relevant statutory regulations and to those persons in the recipient party's organization on a 'need to know' basis only.
- 5.2 All such proprietary confidential information will be kept in confidence and the party receiving the confidential information agrees not to disclose to any other person or persons outside the organization or any unauthorized person or persons except to the organization authorized by either of the parties hereunder on 'need to know' basis for the execution of the collaborative work.

6.0. Intellectual property rights (IPR) protection

- 6.1. IPR generated during the activities under the MoU shall be shared jointly. The extent of ownership shall be decided mutually depending upon the relative level of intellectual inputs made by the parties.
- 6.2. The expenditure incurred and to be incurred for the maintenance of IPR shall be borne by each party equally or in proportion to the extent of ownership as may be decided by authorized authorities of UEMJ and SMART Society, USA mutually.
- 6.3. Both parties shall not file any application for seeking IPR/patent in its own name or in the name of its associates or any other person(s) on any matter relating to the information developed under this MoU. However, they can seek intellectual property rights on joint names of the parties as may be mutually agreed, on case to case basis.
- 6.4. The above principles will apply to all the activities of IPR such as patenting, technology transfer and commercialization of invention developed out of the activities covered under this MoU.

1.0. Notice

8.1 All notices regarding this Agreement shall be by personal delivery or by certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, at the addresses as either of them may so provide by notice given to the other in the same manner.

2.0. Term and termination

The term of this MOU will be for 5 years and may be terminated by any of the parties after serving a notice of at least 3 months. In the event any of any claim, controversy, dispute or difference between Parties, arising out of or in connection with or in relation to this Agreement, either Party will be entitled refer the same to arbitration in accordance with the rules of arbitration of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. There shall be three arbitrators, one to be appointed by Smart Society, the other to be appointed by to University of Engineering & Management, Jaipur and the third to be appointed by the two arbitrators appointed by the Parties. The award of the arbitrators shall be final and binding on the Parties. The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Jaipur.
