Final decision of granting scholarship will be with the Scholarship Committee.</p> <p>Scholarship will be granted on semester basis and continuation in second and further semesters of the program will be paper to scholarship policy. To continue availing 100% scholarship, a student will have to secure position in top 5% of the merit list of the program. For continuation of 50% and 25% scholarship, a student will have to secure position in top 10% of the merit list of the subsequent semester.</p> <p>There will be a scholarship of 10% for local students of Rajasthan.</p>
